direktor škole Dragan Radovanović

„Mi smo zaista uspešna škola, što pokazuju veoma dobri rezultati naših učenika u svim oblastima, a koji potvrđuju kvalitet nastave“, počinje ovaj razgovor direktor OŠ "Vuk Karadžić" u Sočanici, Dragan Radovanović, i dodaje: "Naši đaci redovno učestvuju na sportskim manifestacijama, ekološkim i humanitarnim akcijama, književnim susretima, izložbama, itd".

Uz veliko zalaganje uspevaju da budu u ravnoj liniji sa bilo kojom školom na nivou. Možda je to zbog jednog opšteg mira koji vlada u ovoj školi, koji pruža normalan rad nastavnika i učenika, a i samog direktora. Govoreći o novim školskim trendovima, gospodin Radovanović je jako zadovoljan što u njegovoj školi ne vlada trend narkotika, kao što je slučaj u pojedinim školama u gradskim sredinama.

On nam se pohvalio činjenicom da su u prošloj godini njegovi učenici već u prvom upisnom roku upisali željene srednje škole. I, njegovo interesovanje za te učenike ne prestaje tu. Naime, on se i nakon svršetka osnovne škole raspituje o tim učenicima, upoređujući njihove rezultate u osnovnoj i srednjoj školi. „Ukoliko mi kažu za nekog učenika da je mnogo dobar iz ruskog jezika ili bilo kojeg predmeta u srednjoj, onda ja znam da je nastavnik u osnovnoj školi dobro odradio svoj posao. Ili, obrnuto, shvatim da nastavnik nije dao realnu ocenu, i time ispravljamo neke greške, jer mi ne želimo „veštački“ da favorizujemo decu“.

Kako nam je direktor rekao, kroz razna testiranja tokom školske godine, deca uspevaju da se oslobode tog psihološkog straha testiranja; i prilikom tih testova se može videti da li je nastavnik, zajedno sa učenicima, možda podbacio neku oblast, gde se moraju izvršiti korekcije u radu. Iako imaju dobre uslove za rad, dotakli smo se i teme kabineta, kada je g. Radovanović objasnio da nedostatak kompjutera i kabineta za informatiku, loše utiče na rad učenika, i svaka pomoć ili računar su od velike pomoći. Standard je da bude jedan učenik-jedan kompjuter, međutim, oni su decu podelili u dve grupe od po deset

đaka. Dok je prva grupa na času informatike, druga u hodniku mora da čeka na red.

Ambiciozni planovi za skoriju budućnost

Ova škola broji oko 300 učenika od prvog do osmog razreda sa izdvojenim odeljenjima u selima Vuča i Gornja Sočanica, i 50 radnika nastavnog i vannastavnog osoblja. A, nekada je matična škola imala i izdvojeno odeljenje u selu Borčane, gde se danas nalazi jedna moderna zgrada, u kojoj se planira rekreativni centar za učenike u jednom prirodnom ambijentu, uz zdrav vazduh i hranu. Jednospratna škola se nalazi na 1100 metara nadmorske visine, ima svoju pijaću vodu, trafostanicu, kuhinju i 40tak kreveta.

„Mi smo ovde na Upravnom odboru doneli odluku da se škola ponudi nekoj turističkoj organizaciji i lokalnoj samoupravi, kako bi se stvorio centar za rekreaciju svih učenika sa Kosova. Sa vrlo malim ulaganjem, taj centar može da zaživi (na 20 km od Sočanice), posebno leti i zimi, što je veoma dobro za razvoj

đaka, kao i za razvoj sredine. To će im biti mnogo zdravije od „tehno-života“, kompjutera, Facebook-a, mobilnih telefona i kafića“. Pored ovog projekta, škola sa svojim učenicima organizuje razne akcije prilikom kojih prikupljaju novac, koji kasnije iskoriste za poklone deci koja žive u lošijim uslovima, ili koja su možda invalidi, bolešljiva, ili iz nekih razloga ne dolaze u školu.

Kraj ove priče nikada ne bi došao ukoliko bismo pisali o svim uspesima, kako obrazovno-vaspitnim, tako i humanim akcijama ove škole. Zato, ovu priču završavamo srećnim krajem, i pozitivnom porukom gospodina Dragana Radovanovića. „Što više zaobilaznja negativnih pojava, što manje svih elemenata koji su van škole, dobrih primera od odraslih, dobrotvornih akcija, znanjem i samosvešću možemo uspeti i ostvariti bolju budućnost“.

Ambitious plans for the near future

This school has about 300 students from the first to the eighth grade, with detached departments in the villages of Vuča and Gornja Sočanica, and with 50 teaching and non-teaching staff. And, the main school once had a detached department in the village of Borčane, which today has a modern building, planned to host a students' recreational centre in a natural environment, with healthy air and food. A one-storey school is located at the 1100 meters above the sea level, has its own drinking water, power station, kitchen and about 40 beds.

"We, on the Board of directors here have adopted a decision for the school to be offered to a tourist organization and the local government in order to create a recreational centre for all

"We are truly a successful school, which is shown by very good performances of our students in all areas that also demonstrate the quality of teaching," Director of the elementary school "Vuk Karadžić" in Sočanica, Dragan Radovanović starts this conversation, adding that "our pupils regularly take part in sports events, environmental and humanitarian activities, literary meetings, exhibitions, etc"

With great efforts, they succeed to be on par with any school on that level. Perhaps this is due to this general peace that exists in this school, which provides normal work for teachers and students, as well as for the director too. Speaking of new school trends, Mr. Radovanović is very pleased that the trend of narcotics does not exist in his school, as is the case in some schools in urban areas.

He has boasted to us with the fact that students from his school have managed last year to sign into their desired schools in the very first enrolment period. And, his interest for these students does not stop there. Namely, he continues to inquire about these students after they have finished their elementary education, comparing their results from the elementary and secondary school. "If they tell me that a student was very good in Russian language or any subject in the secondary school, then I know that the teacher from the elementary school has done a good job. Or, conversely, I see that the teacher did not give a realistic grade, and we thereby correct some mistakes, because we do not want to "artificially" favourise children".

As the director told us, children manage to break free of this psychological fear of tests, by taking various tests during the school year; and these tests can show whether the teacher could've failed in a certain field together with the students, where we would then have to make corrections in their work. Although they have good working conditions, we touched upon the topic of specialised classrooms, where Mr. Radovanović explained that the lack of computers and the IT classroom is having a poor influence on the students' work, adding that any help or a computer would be of great assistance. Standard is to have one student use one computer, however, they have split students into two groups of ten pupils. While the first

students from Kosovo. With very low investments, this centre could be brought to life (20 km from Sočanica), especially during the summer and winter time, which is very good for the development of students as well as for the development of an environment. It will be much healthier for them, than the "techno-life" with computers, Facebook, mobile phones, and coffee shops". In addition to this project, the school organizes various activities with its students, where they collect money, which is later used for presents for the children living in poor conditions, or for the disabled or sick children, or those that do not come to school for various reasons.

The end of this story would never be if we continued to talk about all successes, both educational and humanitarian activities of this school. Therefore, we are closing this story with a happy ending, and with the positive message from Mr. Dragan Radovanović. "By bypassing the negative events as much as possible, minimizing all elements that exist outside the school, having good examples from the adults, holding charity events, acquiring knowledge and self-awareness - we can succeed and make a better future".
